This year three individuals were honored for the work they do for Holy Family Home. Interestingly, their acceptance speeches had a common theme – gratitude for having the Little Sisters of the Poor in their lives.



**Father William Kaufman** is pastor of St. Pius X Church in Broomall. He was a seminarian when he met the Little Sisters of the Poor and was drawn to their mission of caring for the elderly poor, as well as to their charism of humility, hospitality, and reliance on God's Providence. He has referred others to our Home and his aunt and mother were also Residents. He has welcomed the Sisters to have church collections at the various parishes where he was pastor. His devotion to St. Jeanne Jugan, the foundress of the Little Sisters, is such that he had a statue made and dedicated at his parish.

**Don Hopkins'** first connection with the Little Sisters of the Poor was when he delivered cookies baked by his mother to the Home. Later his mother, Mary, was a Resident at Holy Family Home. He was so grateful for the care given to her that he decided to be involved with the Pot of Gold fundraiser. He has been a seller for 17 years and this year has sold a personal best of 117 tickets! Don ended his acceptance speech by saying, "Let us pray that our links form a chain of love and friendship that will entwine our hearts with the Little Sisters of the Poor."

The Little Sisters of the Poor have been a part of **Pat Zubyk's** life since she was 12, when she volunteered at their Home in Germantown. She entered the Congregation, but eventually left when she discerned that it was not her calling. However, her faith was strengthened by her time as a Little Sister and she made strong, lasting friendships along her journey. Her ties to the Sisters were renewed when she reconnected with Holy Family Home in 1995, and then took off when she became involved with the Pot of Gold in 2010. She is happy to be

spiritually closer to the Little Sisters when she became an AJJ (Association Jeanne Jugan) lay member in 2012.
